To the Members of the U.S. House of Representatives:

As the House considers long-term highway reauthorization, the U.S. commercial nuclear energy industry urges you to oppose all amendments related to the Export-Import Bank of the United States (Ex-Im Bank).

A majority of the House voted last week in favor of legislation to reform and reauthorize the Ex-Im Bank. This legislation includes the toughest reforms of the Ex-Im Bank to date and is identical to legislation already approved by the Senate.

We greatly appreciate the strong support that the House provided to a reformed and reauthorized Ex-Im Bank. We encourage the House to oppose all amendments to this legislation and to finish the job of reauthorizing the Ex-Im Bank.
